- **Criteria:** Applicant must be a graduating senior attending high school in Palm Beach County, planning to enroll in a <u>Florida 2</u> or 4 year <u>college or university or technical</u> school.
- Scholarships are based on:
 - Financial need demonstrated by submission of current tax returns of parents or guardians or FRL or FAFSA authorization letters
 - Academic performance, requiring a minimum cumulative **GPA** of 3.00.
 - A personal essay of about 550 words "Tell us your story."
 - Two letters of recommendation.

• Other Factors - community service, after school employment, family childcare, school team sports, other extracurricular activities

(Finalists may be subject to a virtual interview)

- **Awards:** At least 30 one-year scholarships of \$5,000 for tuition, books, fees and school sponsored room and meals. Winners notified by March 1st, 2024. (Scholarships do not have to be claimed during first year of attendance).
- Awards Presentation Event is Saturday, April 13, 2024 at the Mirasol Country Club Palm Beach Gardens. You must be present to receive your scholarship.
- Deadline: Applications must be postmarked no later than December 31, 2023
